- To teach children to understand and accept responsibility for their own behavior

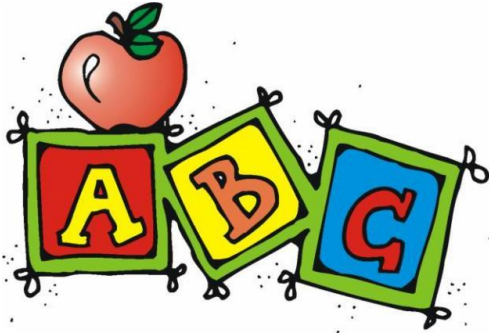
Our goal is to provide your child the tools necessary to begin kindergarten.

A Typical Day in our Classroom...

Center Time/ Free Play

Children learn through play. During this time children choose from a variety of activities including books, imaginative play center, games, etc.

(Skills: self-direction, choice, imagination, turn taking, problem solving and more)

Story Time

We read and share a variety of stories.

(Skills: listening, attention, language, and literacy development)

Table Time/ Art

Provides language opportunities such as talking about Calendar, weather and/or sharing thoughts with classmates. Art projects may be linked to a theme. This allows children to mature in following directions, fine motor skills and creative expression.

(Skills: sharing, following directions, fine motor skills)

Circle/ Music Time

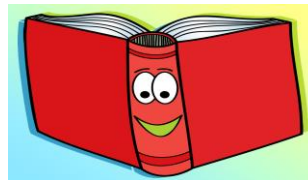
Different experiences during this fun time include active and quiet songs

(skills: unity, movement, memory, expression)

Quiet Book Time

A few minutes of quiet book time allows children to look at pictures in books to help them discover the story.

(Skills: language, imagination, discovery)



Snack Time

As children enjoy snacks, they practice table manners as well as develop social skills while they communicate with peers.

(Skills: socialization, responsibility, nutrition, manners)

Physical Play Time

Each day children enjoy play in the gym or in the exciting outside play areas where they continue developing social skills and gross motor skills.

(Skills: gross motor skills, movement, socialization)
